4. CHAIRPERSON'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

Jubilee celebrations went very well approx. 200 people attended throughout the day, it was a great success.

9. PCSO ADAM ENTWISTLE

PCSO Adam Entwistle and PC Christopher Howard kindly attended the meeting and gave an in depth explanation of their duties and concerns within Higher Hurdsfield.

PCSO produced his monthly report.

Cllr. A. Broadhurst advised the main two problems we have are speeding and parking.

Motor bikes racing on a Sunday afternoon and parking blocking the footpath across the road from the Three Crowns, on the canal bridge and on the double yellow lines on Roewood Lane.

The police are aware of these issues and vehicles have been ticketed.

They asked if we had considered a SID as they say they give statistics and are a deterrent. We have funding waiting for the purchase of a SID but Cheshire East Council are now discouraging SIDS and we are waiting for further direction.

The speeding camera cannot be used in the dark.

The police have no authority to request yellow lines to be painted. They suggested we collect information of the vehicles parking on the bridge, photos, registration nos., times and dates they were parked there etc. this information could then be sent to Traffic which would encourage them to take an interest.

11. LOWER FOLD FARM, "KEEP CLEAR" LINES REQUIRED.

Road Condition.

John Denwood has seen the video and the photos. He is going to assess the area when there is a downpour and he is aware that the real problem is, they need to clear the channels, build up the sides, put warning marker posts in, fill pot holes in etc. There was talk that they would be getting money from the Department of Transport, but there has been no further mention of this. He is not able to give any time scale.

John will also check the gullies to see if any do need clearing.

Funding request from residents in the area.

Funding for a permanent wooden/plastic flower trough to commemorate the Queens Jubilee has been requested by the residents in the Cliff Lane Area.

The residents will provide and look after the contents in the trough.

ACTION Prices to be obtain for the next meeting. Size of trough approx.. 2ft.x 5ft.

13. ROEWOOD LANE.

a. Reported Pot Holes.

Cllr. A, Stott has inspected the area and confirmed the repair has been carried out.

b. Vehicle collision damage to wall and signage.

The situation remains the same as last month.

The job has been raised and costs are recoverable. No programmed date at this moment in time. Permits still to be applied for.
